Annie Apple

Objectives

To teach the letter shapes for **a** and **A** and the short vowel sound /ə/, and to introduce briefly the long vowel /eɪ/.

What you need

Teaching suggestions

Introducing Annie Apple

Show the children the picture of Annie Apple on page 7 of the Letterland ABC Book and introduce her using the sample script for Session 1 (shown right) as a guide for what to say. Invite one or more children to find and touch Annie Apple on the Letterland Alphabet Frieze.

Annie Apple's letter shape

Introduce Session 2. Then sing or chant the handwriting verse shown below as the Handwriting Song CD or Letterland Lucy ABC to help teach Annie Apple's letter shape.

At the end begin. Go round the apple this way. Then add a line down, so Annie won't fall down!

The lyrics for all the Handwriting Songs can be found on page 78 of this book.

Invite one or more children to finger-trace Annie's letter shape on the Letterland ABC Book or on both sides of the Big Picture Code Card.

Things to do

- Annie Apple** Before the children enter, lay a trail of large cardboard or paper arrows for them to follow, get them to find Annie Apple on the Alphabet Frieze or in the ABC Book. *[PSY] Use everyday words to describe positions!*
- Apple tree** Make apple templates for the children to draw round, cut out and use. Help to cut the apples out and display them. *[CD Explore colour, texture, shape.]*
- Apple printing** Cut apples across horizontally to show the 'star' pattern. Invite the children to make apple patterns with them by pressing them on to sponges full of paint. *[CD Explore colour, texture, shape.]*
- Follow the arrow** Make a large cardboard arrow and play Follow the arrow. *[Invite printing the arrow to the left, right, backwards, forwards or backwards, say 'Annie Apple visit Mrs forward!']* The children then stand in the right direction. *[For downwards, the children crouch down.]* *[PSY] Use everyday words to describe positions!*
- Animals** Let the children draw animals beginning with Annie Apple's sound, e.g. an alligator, cat or antelope. If they want to, they could draw their own 'omissing animal'. *[CD Explore and experiment with sounds.]*
- Further practice** Options for letter shapes:
 - Early Years Handwriting Copymasters 1 and 2 for combinations of both letter shape and sound use.
 - Early Years Handbook 1, pages 2-5.
 - Letterland Lucy ABC software.

Things to talk about

- Alphabet** Explain the meaning of the word alphabet, pointing to all the letters on the Alphabet Frieze. Draw attention to **a**, **A** and **and** say that they are all 'alphabet characters'.
- Apple pie** Using apple pie and pictures of trees, talk about how it may grow soon a big tree to give us many more apples.
- Knowing why we say 'A'**
- Explaining the capital A shape**

In Letterland the capital A shapes are called **Apple trees**. The apples on them while they say 'A...'. At the start of important words, such as names like **Anna**, **Andrew**, etc., while Mr A appears beside the Alphabet in names like **Andy** and **Adam** (see below).

Introducing Mr A, the Apron Man

Show the picture of Mr A, the Apron Man, on either the Alphabet Frieze or on the Big Picture Code Card. Explain that Mr A is the man who tells you of Annie Apple and all the apple friends. At special times he appears in words created by Annie Apple and says the name 'A...'. as in **apron**.
